New businesses join Target in north Lafayette shopping center

Stirling Properties announced today the nine retail tenants to occupy a new shopping complex at the intersection of Louisiana Avenue and Interstate 10.

The businesses, and their square footage, are:

- Target - 126,842
- J.C. Penney - 103,525
- Ross - 25,000
- Petco - 16,000
- Office Depot - 21,017
- Rack Room Shoes - 6,050
- Lane Bryant/Cacique - 7,040
- Hibbett Sports - 5,000
- Maurices - 4,020

The retail area will be 480,000 square feet. Contractors on the project have said that Target wants to start construction by May 1, and J.C. Penney hopes to begin by Aug. 1.
