Stirling unveils latest plans for River Chase development

COVINGTON, La. — Covington-based Stirling Properties has unveiled the latest plans for the River Chase development.

Plans calls for office and retail space, apartments, condominiums, hotels and restaurants as part of the development on 168 acres at the southwest quadrant of the new Interstate 12 and Brewster Road interchange in Covington.

When complete, the development will consist of more than 1 million square feet of office space, 1 million square feet of retail space, 240 apartments, about 250 condos, two hotels, restaurants and other retail uses.

Stirling unveiled the latest plans April 21. The first phase of the project, completed in 2004, includes St. Tammany's largest open-air retail center, anchored by Target, Belk, J.C. Penney, Best Buy, Marshall's and Ross. It also features a 14-screen stadium-style theater.
