## Professorship named for developer

**Jimmy Maurin**, chairman of Stirling Properties in Covington, has been honored with a professorship in business at LSU.

Maurin is a LSU alumnus and E.J. Ourso College of Business supporter. He was recognized at a May 14 luncheon held at the LSU Faculty Club.

The James E. "Jimmy" Maurin Professorship in Business was established in the developer's name by his business partner and friend Roger Ogden. It will be used for scholastic purposes by providing support to doctoral students in the E.J. Ourso College, with special consideration given to doctoral students whose areas of research

are real estate and entrepreneurship.

Sterling Properties, founded in 1975, built the Premier Centre in Mandeville and the Sterling Covington Center on Louisiana 21 south of Covington, and is in the process of rebuilding the Hammond mall of Interstate 12.

Maurin is presently chairman of the Ochsner Health Systems Board and has served as the chairman off the International Council of Shopping Centers and is a founding trustee of Blueprint Louisiana. He also served on the E.J. Ourso College Dean's Advisory Council and co-chairs the Louisiana Business Building Oversight Committee.
