Hammond Square secures more stores

Two more Hammond Square stores have been announced.

Stirling Properties announced Tuesday the addition of Coach House Gifts and Nagoya Sushi & Japanese Steakhouse.

Coach House Gifts, now located at 1818 W Thomas St., operates in affiliation as an Hallmark Gold Crown Store, and will move to Hammond Square along Main Street behind Best Buy, said Bezie Landry, Stirling Properties leasing representative.

The specialty store is one of the largest gift chains in the nation, according to company information.

Coach House Gifts is returning to Hammond Square after a long stint at the former mall before its demolition and renovation, Landry said.

Nagoya Sushi & Japanese Steakhouse will open as one of the four restaurants at the west entrance of Hammond Square.

The restaurant, with locations throughout the South and Mid-West, will offer several hibachi grills, a fine dining atmosphere and a full bar, Landry said.
