**Georgia-Pacific's Port Hudson Operations' Motorcycle Bike Run for Charity** raised \$8,500 for the **Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation Louisiana Chapter** in support of its mission to find a cure for diabetes and its complications through research.

**Shell** has donated \$450,000 to help support efforts of the Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries to protect and foster fish and other marine life in the state's coastal waters and the Gulf of Mexico, through the Louisiana Artificial Reef Program.

**Spay Baton Rouge**, which is trying to reduce Baton Rouge's animal euthanasia rate by offering free or reduced-cost spay-and-neuter services, has been selected by celebrity chef Rachael Ray to compete in her national online promotion called Mutt Madness. The organization received \$1,000 for becoming one of the 64 animal-welfare groups to participate in the contest; the winner, which will be determined by public online voting, will receive \$50,000. Interested voters must register on Ray's Web site, rachaelray.com, under the "Pets" tab.

The **Secretary of State's Office** and **Louisiana Public Broadcasting** have been awarded a \$100,000 grant from the Institute of Museum and Library Sciences to develop a plan to preserve and catalog historic videos, films and images. Most of the video and film will be taken from LPB, many of the state's television stations and archived collections.
