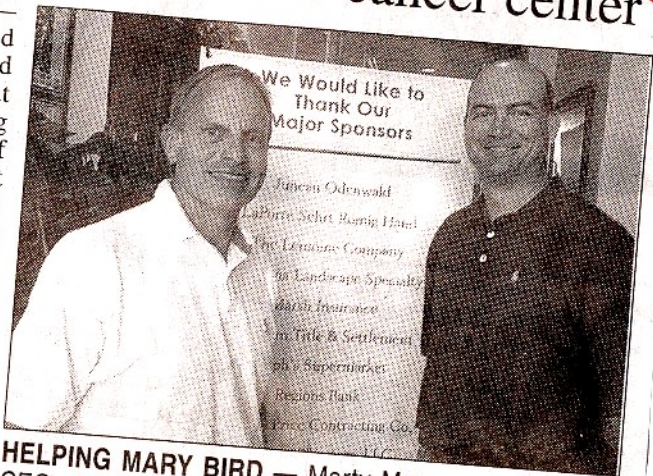
Stirling donates \$10,000 to cancer center
